
Install with double-sided tape



Insert battery
(CR 2032 3V - not supplied).




Remove double-sided
tape's protective layers
and attach to the back of
the mounting plate.




Fix to wall and reattach
remote on off control to the
mounting plate by rotating
it clockwise.


Install with screws





Insert battery (CR 2032 3V - not supplied).





Ensure the mounting plate is level. Hold in position and mark 2 fixing points.

Before drilling, ensure there are no cables or water supplies running within the wall. Drill the marked fixing points.



4
Insert wall plugs and screw in place.



5
Reattach remote on/off control to the mounting plate by rotating it clockwise.

Pairing

- 1 Set shower into pairing mode (see shower instructions).
- 2 Press and hold the remote control's button for approximately 5 seconds. The remote control's LED will flash once and this will now be paired with the shower. Shower LED will stop flashing when pairing is complete.

Troubleshooting

Fault	Cause	Remedy
LED not emitting	Coin cell is installed in the wrong orientation	Flip the coin cell so that positive side is exposed. To re-connect, see pairing (page 3).
LED flashes twice every 10 seconds	Coin cell needs replacing	Replace with CR 2032 3V coin cell battery. To re-connect see pairing (page 3).
LED flashes 3 times on remote, but won't connect	Too far away from shower unit (max 20 m)	Move closer to the shower unit.
	Shower isolation switch turned off	Turn on shower isolation switch.
	Not paired	See pairing (page 3).

Cleaning Recommendations

Always isolate power supply before cleaning.

The remote on off control and surrounding areas should be cleaned periodically to remove any accumulation of dirt or other waste materials, using domestic bathroom and kitchen cleaning materials with a soft cloth.

Do not use abrasive pads or cloths. Do not use strong or concentrated acidic, alkaline or other cleaning materials as these may damage or discolour the product.

After cleaning wipe thoroughly with a damp soft cloth to remove any cleaning material residue.

Warranty applies only to manufacturing or material defects, conditional on the one-time correct installation of the product. It does not apply to:

- Inappropriate use or accidental damage.
- Damage or defects that result from incorrect installation.
